CREAM CHEESE BAKED SPAGHETTI

Main Ingredients

- 1 lb spaghetti uncooked
- 8 oz cream cheese softened
- 2 cups marinara sauce store-bought or homemade
- 1 cup mozzarella cheese shredded

Preparation Steps

- Preheat the oven to 350°F (175°C).
- Cook the spaghetti according to package instructions and drain.
- In a mixing bowl, blend the softened cream cheese with the warm spaghetti.
- Spread half of the marinara sauce in the bottom of a baking dish.
- Layer the spaghetti mixture on top of the sauce, followed by the remaining sauce.
- Top with shredded mozzarella cheese.
- Bake for 20-25 minutes or until the cheese is bubbly and golden brown.
