Fluffy Cranberry Cheese Pie

Cranberry Topping:

- 1 package (3 ounces) raspberry flavored gelatin
- $\frac{1}{3}$ cup sugar
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ cups cranberry juice
- 1 can (8 ounces) jellied cranberry sauce

Filling:

- 1 package (3 ounces) cream cheese, softened
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup sugar
- 1 tablespoon milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 1 (9 inch) baked pastry shell or Graham cracker crust



In a mixing bowl, combine gelatin and sugar; set aside. In a saucepan, bring cranberry juice to a boil. Remove from heat, pour over gelatin mixture, stirring to dissolve. Stir in the cranberry sauce. Chill until slightly thickened. Meanwhile, in another mixing bowl, beat cream cheese sugar, milk and vanilla until fluffy. Fold in the whipped topping. Spread evenly into the pie shell. Beat cranberry topping until frothy; pour over filling. Chill overnight. Yield: 6-8 servings.
